- **Dealing with uncertainty**

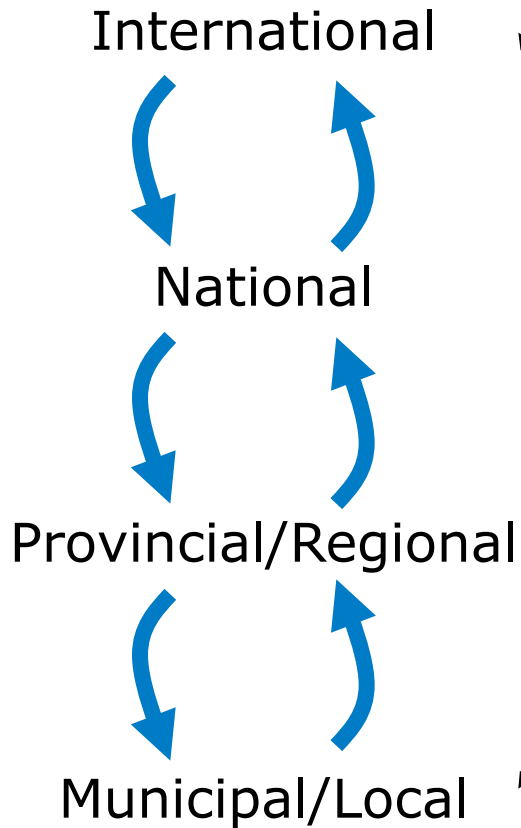
Important to assess the impact of the governance of water on the environment

- **Involvement of many stakeholders**

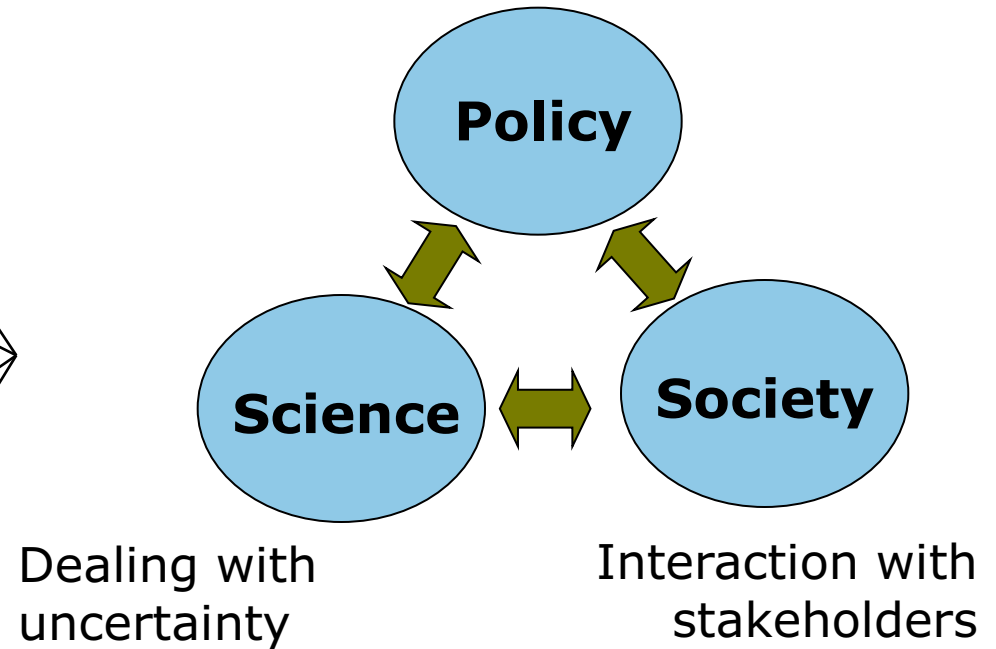
Consensus, participation and development of a shared vision for society

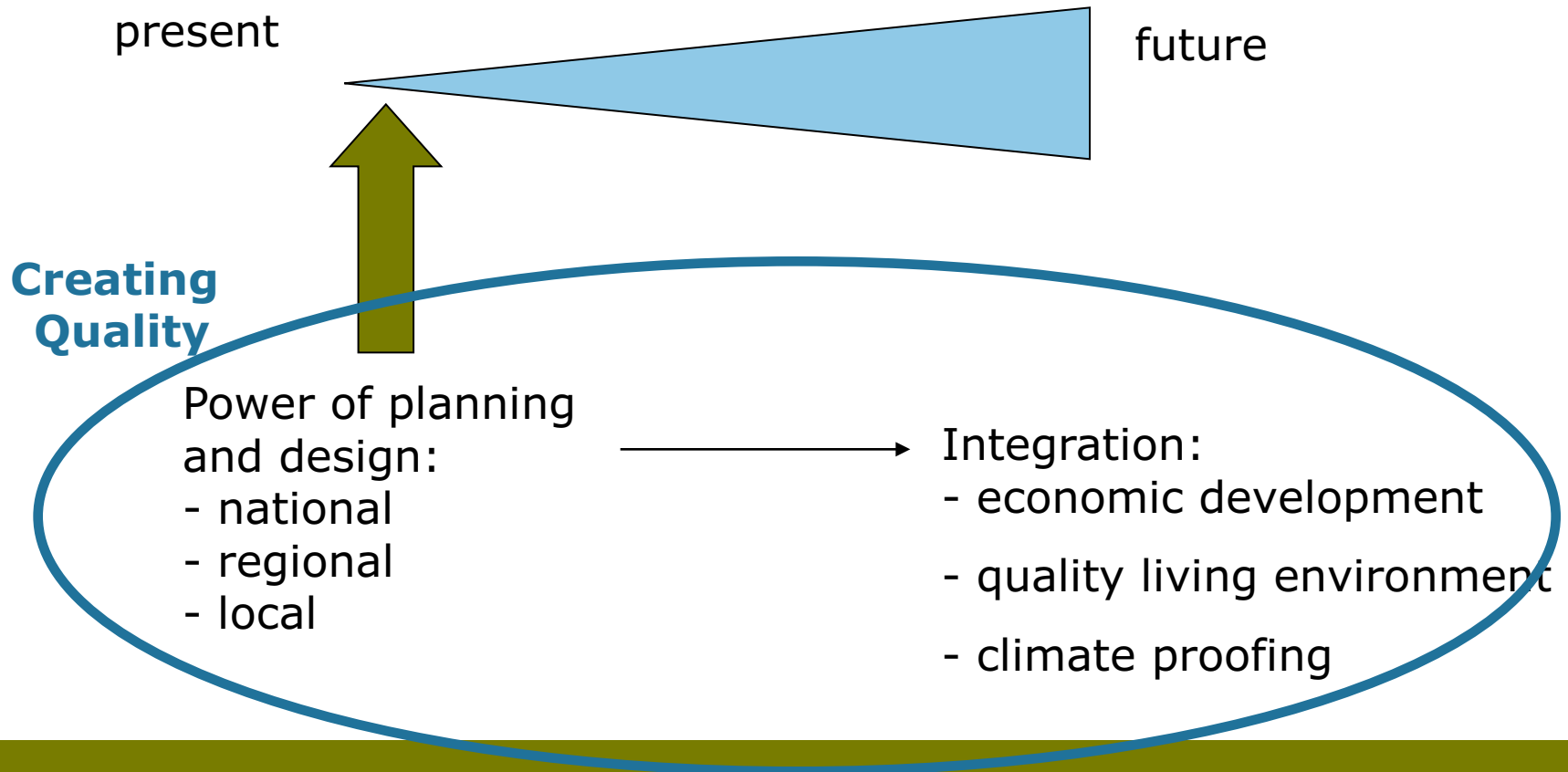
Interaction between government levels
